Some of the highlights of the trip:

- 1,600 representatives from electric cooperatives all across the nation will be in D.C., including about 40 youth from Minnesota electric cooperatives. Meet with your Members of Congress and make new lifelong friends
- Tour the monuments: Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Korean Veterans Memorial, World War II Memorial, Arlington Cemetery, Air Force Memorial and Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial.
- **Tour historic sites:** Smithsonian Museums, Holocaust Museum, Mount Vernon, Newseum and 9/11 Memorial.
- Attend special events: Congressional Insight, theater performance, river cruise and all-state dance.
- **Go places:** Interview to be the Minnesota representative on the Youth Leadership Council. If selected, you will travel back to D.C. next year as an assistant on next year's Youth Tour and travel to the National Rural Electric Convention in Orlando, FL, March 7-14, 2019.
