In this role, you will own day-to-day operations, deploy and maintain server infrastructure, administer cloud-based applications (including Teams, SharePoint, and etc.), and provide troubleshooting, root cause identification, and technical support to the entire organization.

The successful candidate will be a versatile self-starter, a continuous learner, and always ready to collaborate with field and office colleagues, leadership, and external partners. Strong communication skills, both verbal and written, combined with an attention to detail and accuracy are essential. Problem-solving abilities and a proven ability to multi-task and meet deadlines are critical for this role. Candidates will have a minimum of an Associate's degree or equivalent work experience, along with multiple IT certifications and 2-5 years of experience in a customercentric IT or technical support role.
